## **Position Description**

The role of Associate is to provide high level administrative, organisational and executive support to her Honour and involves court work, assistance in the preparation of judgments, liaising with the Court registry and the legal profession and other tasks that facilitate the efficient conduct of chambers. Access to her Honour is managed by the Associate. Effective issue management techniques and high-level communication skills are essential. The Associate liaises with other chambers and the registry on her Honour's behalf. Legal qualifications are an advantage but are not essential to the role.

- Familiarity with, or experience working in, a legal environment;
- Proven experience in the provision of professional executive support services;
